Kyoung's Pacific Beat culminated its 2016-2017 season with an artistic residency at the Baryshnikov Arts Center and produced a workshop production of PILLOWTALK at LaGuardia Performing Arts Center's Rough Draft Festival. The Spring of 2017 marked Kyoung's completion of The Field's inaugural Field Leadership Fund Fellowship program, which seeks to promote racial equity in arts. Our 2017-2018 season included a staged reading of NERO at New Ohio Theater's Producer's Club and the announcement of PILLOWTALK's World Premiere in Jan. 2018, in a co-production with The Tank. Educational activities include two student workshops in Seoul, South Korea and Santiago, Chile.

Kyoung's Pacific Beat's audience is comprised of mainly queer, LGBQT communities of color; independent, experimental artists; and undergraduate students.

What are your plans for the project for 2018?

PILLOWTALK premiered Jan. 2018 at The Tank, received rave reviews including from The New York Times, and will tour to the National Asian-American Theater Conference and Festival at Victory Gardens in Chicago this August 2018.
